Breakfast/Lunch Program, Pricing, and Policy

- Breakfast and Lunch menus are available on the South Heart School website under the "Calendars/Menus" tab
- Milk/Juice Break (PK-4) \$.30/day
- Breakfast (begins at 8:05 am)
 - K-12 Breakfast \$1.95/meal
 - K-12 2nd helping \$1.30/meal
- Lunch
 - K-6 Lunch \$2.95/meal
 - K-6 2nd helping \$1.30/meal

 - 7-12 Lunch \$3.15/meal
 - 7-12 2nd helping \$2.30/meal
- Reduced Pricing (for those that qualify by application)
 - K-12 Breakfast \$0.00 (paid by state)
 - K-12 Lunch \$0.40/meal
- Free/Reduced Pricing (for those that qualify by application)

Free and reduced pricing only applies to the 1st meal. 2nd helpings are not covered by free and reduced pricing, and therefore ALL students who choose a 2nd helping are charged the full 2nd helping price for both breakfast and lunch. This includes students that return to the salad bar for a 2nd helping.
- Payment

Payments for breakfast and lunch can be made at the school office or preferably online using the Efund link on our school website. Payments for milk/juice break for grades PK-4 can only be made at the school office.

**** Hot Lunch Payment Policy****

All students in Grades K-12 will be **REQUIRED TO PREPAY for individual meals at the beginning of the school year**. When making payment by check, make it payable to South Heart School. Payment by credit card may be made through the EFunds link on the school website. Always check to see if you qualify for free or reduced meals. If you think you may be eligible, please apply.

If a student's balance falls below \$0.00, parents/guardians will be notified by an automated message sent via email and/or text and/or automated phone call. Parents/guardians are then requested to make immediate payment within 1 week.

If a student's balance falls below -\$20.00, parents/guardians shall be contacted directly by the South Heart School main office. Payment is required within 1 week. If payment is not made within 1 week, the District will vigorously pursue the collection of outstanding debt, which may include contacting collection agencies, Social Services, and/or Law Enforcement.
